The Mobilitätsticket Brandenburg

The Mobilitätsticket Brandenburg is a personal monthly ticket issued at a reduced price. Passengers save 50 percent compared to the price of a VBB-Umweltkarte (VBB environmental ticket). The Mobilitätsticket Brandenburg is exclusively issued as a monthly ticket.



Eligibility for the Mobilitätsticket Brandenburg is granted to current recipients of the following benefits:

- Those included in the SGB II, including social benefits
- Social welfare (SGB XII, including guaranteed minimum pension and basic security benefits for reduction in earning capacity)
- Integration aid according to Part 2, SGB IX (3rd stage of the Federal Participation Law – BTHG)
- Those included in the Asylum Seekers Benefits Act (AsylbLG)

and members of communities in need

Pupils who receive a subsidy for school transport are not entitled to a Mobilitätsticket Brandenburg; please contact the school authority. In most cases, school-age children from families in need receive a VBB student fare card for which the parents do not have to pay a co-payment.

The Mobilitätsticket Brandenburg is valid for all means of transport in the VBB network. Depending on individual needs, it can be acquired for various geographic areas of validity. Within the area of validity, trains and buses can be used as often as desired. The Mobilitätsticket Brandenburg is **not valid for journeys to Berlin.***

VBB customer card

The Mobilitätsticket Brandenburg consists of a VBB customer card (VBB-Kundenkarte) with photo on which the authorisation is certified and a value coupon (Wertabschnitt) for the respective period and geographic area of validity. Entitlement for the Mobilitätsticket Brandenburg is checked at the competent office (e.g. job centre, social welfare office) where the benefits are received. That is where the VBB customer card is issued. The benefits office provides the VBB customer card with the personal information (surname, first name, photo) and indicates the validity period. Depending on the duration of the entitlement to benefits, this validity period is usually up to six months. Eligible persons must bring a photo with them the first time the VBB customer card is issued.



The VBB customer card has a limited validity period. If a benefit continues to be received after the validity of the VBB customer card has expired, its validity must be extended by the respective benefits office. If no more benefits are received, the VBB customer card must be returned to the issuing office or to the transport company.

Value coupons

Value coupons are sold by the transport companies at their customer centres; in specific cases, the Mobilitätsticket Brandenburg is also available for purchase from ticket vending machines or transport operators. The respective area and period of validity are indicated on the value coupon.

Furthermore, the VBB customer card number must be specified on the value coupon, as the Mobilitätsticket is personal and non-transferable. Value coupons are only valid if the VBB customer card number is specified.

Carriage regulations

The Mobilitätsticket Brandenburg allows children under the age of six, a pram, luggage and a dog to be brought along free of charge. To transport a bicycle, a bicycle ticket is required. It is not possible to take people with you free of charge.



Tip

The Deutschlandticket is an alternative to the Mobilitätsticket Brandenburg for journeys in more than one Landkreis (rural district) or to Berlin or other states in Germany. It is a personal season ticket and is available as a monthly subscription from your local transport company. A VBB customer card is not required.
